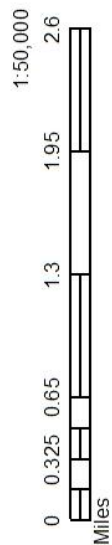


Route 11: Bowlees Visitor Centre, Middleton-in-Teesdale and Grassholme Reservoir

Route 11: Bowlees Visitor Centre, Middleton-in-Teesdale and Grassholme Reservoir

Length: 18 miles (27.5km) **Time:** 2.5 – 3 hours

Start: Bowlees Visitor Centre

Key: **R** = Right | **L** = Left | **TR** = Turn right | **TL** = Turn left | **SP** = Signposted | **T-j** = T-junction

1. From Bowlees Visitor Centre TL onto the main road
2. After 600m TL onto a narrow walled road, SP to Westgate
3. TR at the T-j and follow the Road around the L bend and up a steep hill
4. TR at the T-j and follow this road for approx. 3km to Middleton-in-Teesdale
5. TL at the T-j, join the main road and cross the bridge into the village
6. Heading through the village, after the L bend TR, SP to Cotherstone
7. Follow the road for approx. 1km and join the Tees Railway Walk on the R. Follow the Railway Path for 5km to Romaldkirk.
8. TR at the T-j and go straight on at the x-roads to follow a track across the moor.
9. TR at the T-j and follow the minor road
10. At the T-j, TR to Mickleton village (you can TL for a short detour to Grassholme Reservoir and Visitor Centre)
11. TL at the T-j and return to Middleton-in-Teesdale.

From Middleton-in-Teesdale retrace your route back to Bowlees
