

Route 5: Three counties & Killhope Museum



Length: 15 miles (24km) Time: 1.5 – 2 Hours Start: Killhope Museum

Key: R = Right | L = Left | TR = Turn right | TL = Turn left | SP = Signposted | T-j = T-junction

- 1. Taking care when crossing the ford, TL out of Killhope Museum onto A689, continue along this road for 2.5 miles.
- 2. Shortly after crossing the county boundary into Cumbria TR SP Carrshield and Allenheads. Take this road, a steady climb takes you onto the moor and into the county of Northumberland.
- 3. TL SP Allenheads after 1.5 miles. Follow the road over the moor, after 3 miles cross a cattle grid and continue with care as the road takes you into the East Allen valley.
- 4. TR at T-j, the road takes you along the East Allen into Allenheads. Continue round to the left as the road takes you up hill.
- 5. TR SP Cowshill onto the B2695 and follow the road out of Allenheads. Take care on the road leaving Allenheads, sharp bends and a steep ascent take you onto the moor and into County Durham.
- 6. As you come down into Cowshill TR on a hairpin SP Killhope
- Continue along the A689. After to 2.4 TL SP Killhope Museum, taking care crossing the ford.
